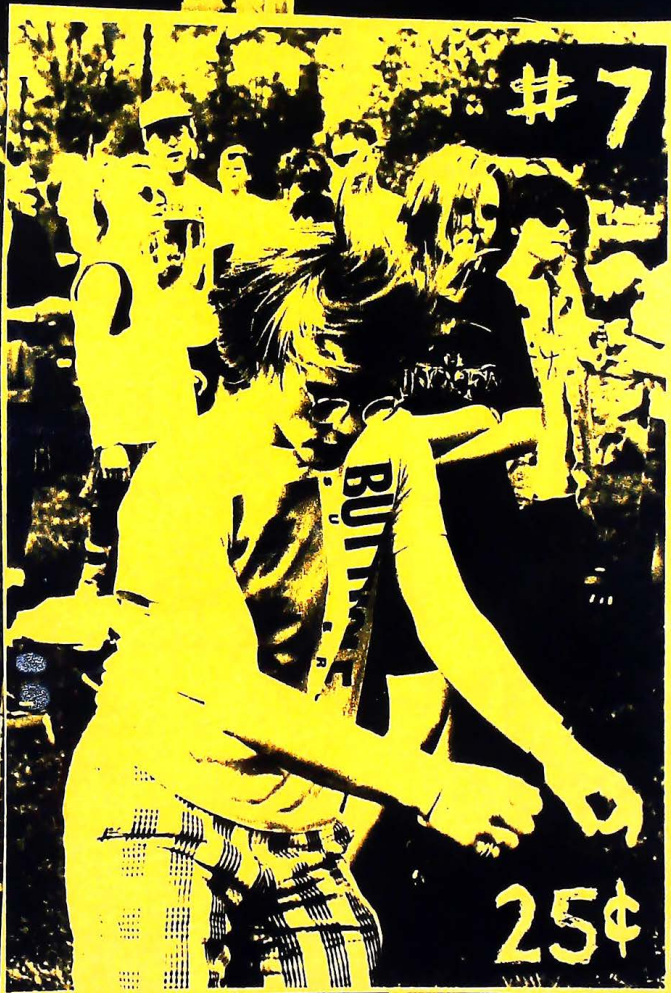

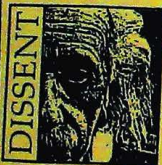

WARNING: GRAPES ARE HAZARDOUS  
TO YOUR HEALTH

**USA TODAY: Is that partly the reason for your boycott — to get tests made?**

**CHAVEZ:** What we want is for the growers to test the grapes at the market level, so that the consumers then will know what's in the grapes, and they'll have an option whether to buy or not.

## We have to get off the pesticide path

**USA TODAY: Can't consumers just wash the pesticide residue off grapes?**

**CHAVEZ:** Not really. Some pesticides are systemic, and they can't be washed off. The systemic pesticide becomes part of the system of the grape. It's one and the same with the grape. And all pesticides are mixed with an adhesive, because the pesticide has to cling literally to the fruits, so it'll stay there and do its job. And you can't really wash it.

**USA TODAY: Are you talking about cancer?**

**CHAVEZ:** For consumers, we're talking about cancer. But for the work force, and their families, and other people who live in those rural communities, we're saying that they're getting cancer and birth defects in large numbers because of the water contamination and the drift.

**USA TODAY: Do you have any hard evidence of the effects on consumers?**

**CHAVEZ:** The Department of Food and Agriculture has tested grapes in California, and there is residue on those grapes. Now, while there have been no studies made about the impact of those residues on the consumer, we do know just by putting two and two together that if you eat pesticide residue, you eat poison, and if you eat poison, you're bound to be hurt.

Grapes now being sold in the East are laced with toxic chemicals. As consumers learn this, they are refusing to buy them.

Cesar Chavez and the United Farm Workers (UFW) have documented cases of pesticide poisoning of farmworkers that have caused birth defects, cancer and untimely death. *Many of these poisons can't be washed off and leave a residue that threatens your health.*

In 1970, 17 million Americans joined the UFW in boycotting grapes and successfully banned DDT. Later, it was banned from all food products.

**USA TODAY: Are farm workers suffering from the use of these pesticides?**

**CHAVEZ:** The first problem is direct-contact poisoning. Then we have problems with drift, where pesticides drift into where people play, and live, and worship. Then we have the added problem where the pesticides leach down into the water and people drink the water. It's really the contamination of the whole environment, and that's what makes it such a big problem.

The following excerpt is from a letter written by the French author Alexandre Dumas (The Count of Monte Cristo, The Three Musketeers) to a Southern Democrat:

Paris 1847

Sir,

My mother was a negro and I am not ashamed to confess that my person makes open declaration of my lineage.... I am anxious to visit your country... One thing deters me... I am told that my African blood will subject me to inconvenience in your country, and that I may even be taken and sold as a slave, according to existing laws.

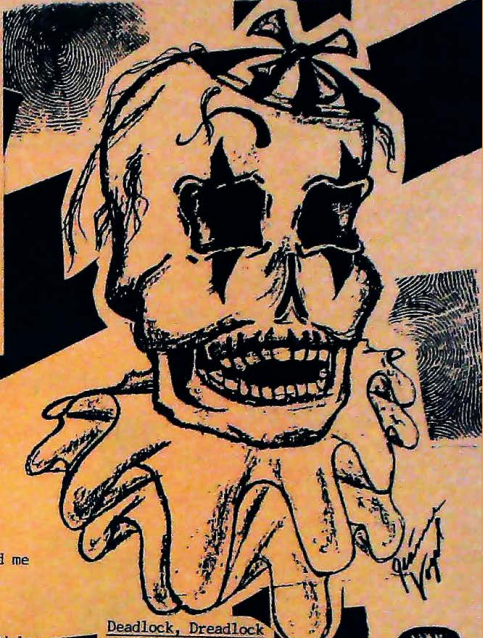

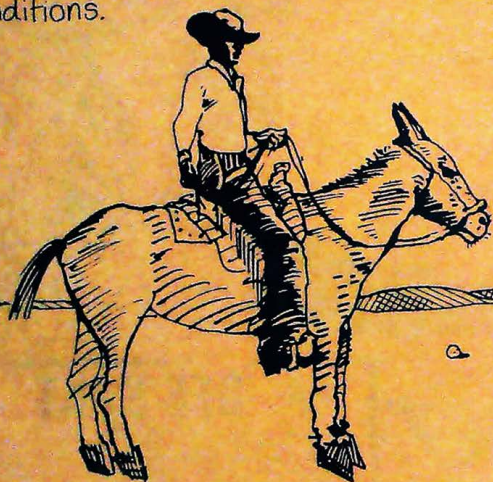

# "VEGETARIANS NEED TO BE CAREFUL"



## HUMAN HEALTH

(questioning the nutritional adequacy of a vegetarian diet)

- Vegetarians need to be careful.

Vegetarians are already very careful about their diet. This is why they reject meat and other animal products. The folks that need to be concerned about the hazards of a vegetarian diet are those in the meat processing, medical care, and undertaking industries who profit from human disease and death.

**General response**—There has never been a confirmed case of anyone getting sick or dying for lack of meat in their diet. On the other hand, each year, 1.5 million Americans are crippled and killed by heart failure, stroke, cancer, and other chronic killer diseases that have been linked to excessive consumption of meat by every expert panel appointed to study the relationship between diet and health.

- Where do you get your protein?

From the same sources that most other people do: grains, legumes, nuts, and other plant foods. Unlike others, however, we do avoid the excess protein from meat and other animal products which are laced with fat, cholesterol, pesticides, hormones, antibiotics, and similar harmful ingredients and place an unnecessary burden on the consumer's digestive system, liver, and kidneys.

- The vegetarian diet is too complicated (or time-consuming).

Most vegetarian dishes require less preparation, cooking, and cleaning up than typical meat dishes. Elimination of meat leaves no vacancy and requires no replacement. However, individuals who enjoy elaborate gourmet preparations will find plenty of material in most vegetarian cookbooks.

- Plants are alive too!

Absolutely. People who are concerned about plant life should become at least vegetarians. This way they will consume only a small fraction of plants that must be fed to livestock to yield an equivalent amount of animal food. What are you doing for plants?

# (and other common myths about a meatless diet)

- I do enough for animals, without becoming a vegetarian.

That's most unlikely. The number of warm-blooded animals brutalized and slaughtered for food each year is approximately 70 times the number of animals killed in laboratories, 30 times the number killed by hunters and trappers, and 500 times the number killed in pounds. An animal welfare advocate who eats meat is personally responsible for the slaughter of 22 warm-blooded animals per year, 1,500 in a life time and probably many more, slaughtered for the advocate's meat-eating family and pets.

- Nations that don't get enough meat suffer from malnutrition.

The best indicators of malnutrition are poor health and short life expectancy. Nations with the highest per capita consumption of meat (U.S., Canada, Argentina, New Zealand) also suffer from the highest incidence of heart failure, stroke, cancer, and other chronic killer diseases. On the other hand, the risk of contracting these diseases for U.S. vegetarians is one-third of that for the general U.S. population.

- I like meat too much to quit.

That's serious, but curable. Unlike the tobacco and alcohol habit, the custom of meat consumption can be broken gradually, first once a week, then once a day, and by switching, first to poultry and fish, and then to eggs and dairy products. Soybean based meat analogs can help in the transition as well. More detested types just turn off the meat habit overnight.

- Vegetarianism may be O.K. for adults, but children need meat.

Growing children need ample protein, calcium, and other minerals for body building, carbohydrates for energy, and vitamins to make it all work. Meat is rich in protein and iron, but it also contains saturated fat and cholesterol and depletes calcium from the bones.

- We need a balanced diet.

Absolutely. This is why most vegetarians partake daily of the four basic food groups: grains and legumes, leafy vegetables, fruit, and eggs and dairy products (optional). Meat unbalances our diet by introducing excessive amounts of fat, cholesterol, pesticides, hormones, and antibiotics.

Vernon Reid is the most passionate guitarist that I have ever seen. As well as being the founder of the Black Rock Coalition, he plays with an EARTH-SHAKING new band from New York who just released their debut album "Vivid" on Epic Records. No, this isn't punk or hardcore, but moral, social-political rock. Though you will probably see this band moving to the top of whatever, they are still on the club circuit, although unfortunately they play mostly 21+ shows. Anyway, on the record "Vivid", it's sort of like the Bad Brains, sort of like Fishbone, half rockmetal, half funk and a hell of a hard thing to explain. Key songs include "Cult of personality", "Desperate People", Talking Heads Cover "Memories can't wait", and a funky song about racism called "Funny Vibe" with Chuck D. and Flavor Flav from Public Enemy. Open Your Mind And Buy It. But, while the record is a must for any collection it must be said that it is toy in comparison to the live thing. While in Wisconsin I got a chance to see them in a little bar called O Cayz Corral. I had heard endless praise about Living Colours live performances, and it was worth every bit of hype. Extended rap and funk pieces, precisely chosen covers (a rock singalong of Tracy Chapman's "Talkin' Bout A Revolution", "Should I Stay or Should I Go", and ending with that Golden Oldie Classic "Johnny Be Goode"), and that priceless ability to get people to shake bootie. While Vernon Reid gets all the notice in this band, onstage you can tell that they are a real unit. Vocalist Corey Glover is a great singer with an excess of Charisma, and it would be in poor taste to neglect mention of funky-a-s bassist Muzz Skillings and drummer William Calhoun. This is one of the best live performances that I have ever seen. NO S\*ST.



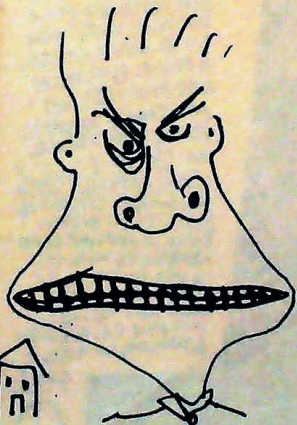

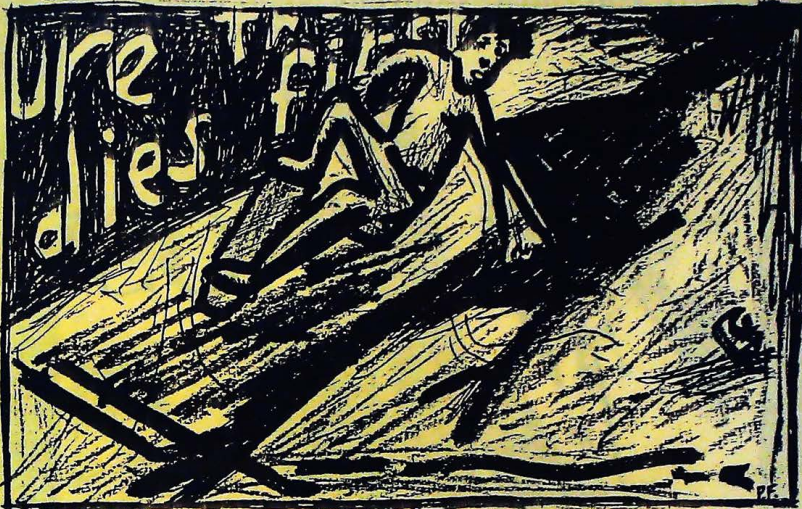
